Update on C.R.

The new *Celebrate Recovery*[®] ministry kicked-off on schedule on September 9th and has been going each Saturday evening since. This has been a tremendous milestone that Net Mender Mission has seen come to fruition and the praise all goes to God and His timing.

Rochester Assembly of God has graciously donated the use of their facility and other resources to help in this effort. Over 40 adults have become involved with Celebrate Recovery during the first few weeks of operation. There are two women's small groups and one men's. Some groups are beginning to meet during the week in addition to the CR small group time. We are looking for more leaders and co-leaders to equip and place in these positions. God has blessed our time with an open atmosphere of personal sharing as we strive to focus on the Person of Jesus Christ.

Relationship Components of CR

Celebrate Recovery is about a journey of discipleship. The process involves some key relationship components.

- **RELATIONSHIP COMPONENT ONE** is worshipping Christ together and reaching, teaching, and testimony from the trenches. He encourages us in celebration as we draw near to Him and prepares us to draw near to one another.
- **RELATIONSHIP COMPONENT TWO** is a small group time immediately following worship where personal thoughts and feelings are expressed based on that which God has just taught us in relationship component one.
- **RELATIONSHIP COMPONENT THREE** is the fellowship and food time after the group hour. Here further relationship and accountability opportunities may be nurtured.
- **RELATIONSHIP COMPONENT FOUR** is the development of leadership. Celebrate Recovery is a leadership factory. Group leaders and co-leaders have been lifted up by God to facilitate the small groups and further encourage His work among those on the Road to Recovery.



Thank you so much for your prayers and support! I am funded partly through my job with the State of Minnesota and partly through the generous gifts of *Net Menders & Tenders* like yourself. At this stage I am exerting about

20 hours a week into developing leaders, counseling people, preparing the lesson and testimonies, and communicating with many individuals. This has a very likely potential to increase as we continue to move forward with mending broken lives and engaging the church in the business of reaching out to these people.

My desire is still to become full time in this ministry. This is a real challenge for the Net Mender team as we would be looking at raising at least \$30,000 more a year over our current levels.
